

2000 - PRESENT

- Webster's Falls Park land transferred from the Town of Dundas to the Hamilton Conservation Authority on January 7, 2000 as part of the Spencer Gorge Wilderness Area.
- 2000 - Webster's Falls/Spencer Gorge Wilderness Area Draft Master Plan prepared with the following objectives
 - improve the function of the joint parklands; and,
 - maintain the cultural and environmental integrity of the landscapes.
- Webster's Falls/Spencer Gorge Draft Management Plan prepared with an objective to provide a safe environment for visitors, improve access and develop a strong link between Webster's Fall and Spencer Gorge Wilderness Area.

- 2002-2003 - Greenville Optimist Community Park constructed with help of community volunteers and donations..
 - Winter 2002--Park design, Park and trail construction plans, and Business Plan finalized.
 - June 2002--Funding campaign initiated. (Optimist Club of Greenville raised \$135,000.)
 - October 2002--Start up of construction work.
 - 08 November, 2003--Official opening of Optimist Park and Optimist Trail.
- Webster's Falls Park identified/included in Niagara Escarpment Plan's Parks and Open Space System.
- 2007 - Hamilton Waterfalls and Cascades Research & Inventory Report prepared.
- Dundas Valley 50-Year Vision & Strategy 2008-2058 prepared.
- 2010 - October - Dobson McKee Lookout: Funding for improvements donated in honour of Wilma F. McKee and Thomas Ss Dobson who grew up in the Dundas Valley.
- 2011 Niagara Escarpment Parks and Open Space System Manual (Draft) released:

- The Niagara Escarpment Plan requires all park and open spaces agencies to prepare a master/management plan for each park and open space in the Niagara Escarpment Parks and Open Space System (NEPOSS).
- Provides guidance to agencies on the design, development, implementation and maintenance of those management plans.
