

SPENCER GORGE-WEBSTER'S FALLS CONSERVATION AREA MASTER PLAN

UPDATE – November 16, 2012

The Hamilton Conservation Authority has now received the final draft master plan document for the Spencer Gorge-Webster's Falls Conservation Area from our consultants GSP Group Inc. and Paradigm Transportation Solutions Inc. The full master plan document is available for viewing or download on the HCA's website at www.conservationhamilton.ca

Attached is an Executive Summary of the proposed master plan including a drawing of the recommended plan.

The consultants will be making a presentation on the draft master plan to the Conservation Advisory Board at their regular monthly meeting scheduled for Thursday, December 13, 2012. This meeting will be held at the Woodend Auditorium at the HCA Administration Offices located at 838 Mineral Springs Rd. in Ancaster. The meeting will commence at 7:00 pm.

This meeting is another step in the overall public consultation process for the Spencer Gorge-Webster's Falls master plan and the general public is welcome to attend and make their views on plan known to the Conservation Advisory Board. The Advisory Board is responsible for making recommendations to the HCA Board of Directors on the important matter.

If you are unable to attend the meeting scheduled for December 13th, the HCA welcomes written comments on the plan which will be passed on to the Advisory Board members as part of their deliberations.
