



Condensation

As the gaseous water cools, it returns to a solid state. The droplets often form around dust and other particles in the air.

Precipitation

Water that falls to the ground. They can fall as rain, snow, or ice. Some of this water is absorbed into this ground in what is known as **infiltration**.

Evaporation

Water turns into gas through heat and/or pressure. Plants also naturally release water vapour. This is called **Transpiration**.
