

PICNICKING

Fifty Point has five picnic areas, and two sheltered pavilions available for reservation. All bookings come equipped with a volleyball net, charcoal BBQ and a number of picnic tables. Picnic tables are also available throughout the day use area on a first come, first served basis. Alcohol is strictly prohibited.



PETS

Pets are welcome at Fifty Point, but must be leashed at all times and not left unattended. Clean up after your pet and have respect for the flora and fauna. Pets are not allowed at the main beach, but may access the multi-use beach area.

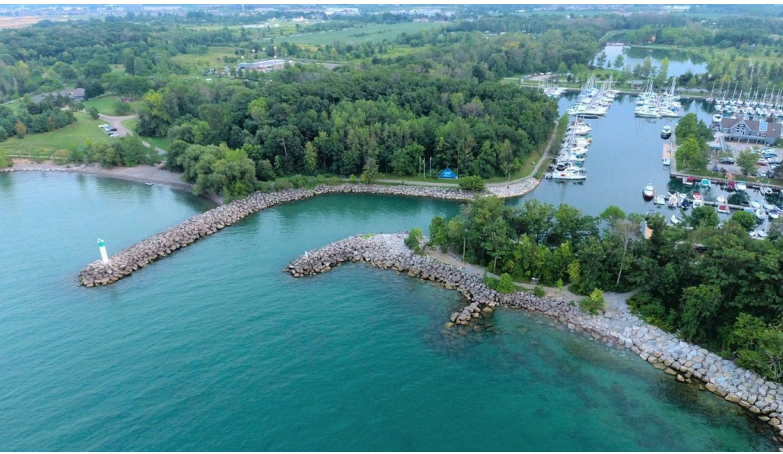

WELCOME TO FIFTY POINT

Welcome to Fifty Point Conservation Area, a magnificent 80-hectare park situated on the shores of Lake Ontario. Located on the Hamilton and Niagara border in Stoney Creek, Fifty Point boasts superb marina facilities. It's the place to be for swimming in Lake Ontario, family camping, or picnicking with a group of any size. Visitors can also enjoy a fabulous lakefront view by walking the promenade, or while relaxing at conveniently located benches and shaded areas.



BIRDING

Fifty Point is recognized as one of the bird watching hotspots in the Golden Horseshoe. With a viewing platform overlooking the water, birders can watch numerous ducks, gulls and waterfowl. Stroll the designated Bluebird Box Trail and see the birds in flight.



CAMPING

Fifty Point has 30 full service seasonal campsites, and 40 full service overnight campsites that can be reserved up to 11 months in advance. Our comfort station is open for showers, washrooms and laundry facilities. The campground is perfectly situated near the south shore of Lake Ontario, allowing campers to access the beach and salmon fishing from shore; or take a day trip along the Niagara Escarpment and enjoy multiple wineries and fruit farms.

SWIMMING

Fifty Point is proud to have one of the cleanest beaches in western Lake Ontario. Our beach is partially sand and stone. There is plenty of room to sprawl out and soak in the sun. Water is tested weekly during the summer. Adults, children are your responsibility. There are no lifeguards on duty.



THE FIFTY POINT MARINA

The marina is one of the best on western Lake Ontario, with docking space for 330 boats and a double boat launch. Other marina facilities include a fully serviced gas dock and pump-out station, visitor docks, hydro hook-ups, water, showers, washrooms, a laundromat and winter storage facilities.



FISHING

Come test your luck in Lake Ontario or our newly naturalized fishing pond which is home to bass and perch. The fishing pond is easily accessible by foot and a great spot for any introductory angler. Fishing in the Marina is prohibited.



FIFTY POINT SITE MAP

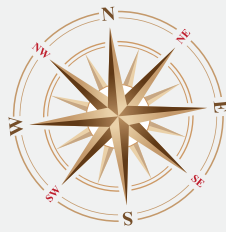
