

Lakeland Pool Weather Suspension Policy

The Hamilton Conservation Authority makes every effort to open Lakeland Pool rain or shine. The Hamilton Conservation Authority may delay the pool's opening, close the pool early, or make other changes to the posted facility schedule when guest safety, staffing levels or other operational concerns make it necessary to do so. Delays and closures will be posted on the Hamilton Conservation Authority website as soon as possible.

For your safety, we reserve the right to suspend operations temporarily during inclement weather, such as a thunderstorm/lightning, dangerous weather, high winds, or cold temperatures. Lakeland Pool may reopen when the safety of patrons and employees is assured.

If we hear thunder or see lightening in close proximity to Lakeland Pool, or experience other operational concerns, operations will be suspended for a minimum of 30 minutes after the last sounding of thunder and/or visual observation of lightening.

Admissions will not be sold during a pool closure. The Hamilton Conservation Authority recommends guests to check the weather prior to visiting, and use their own discretion when purchasing admission on days with poor weather conditions.

Refunds or rain checks will not be issued.
