- Conducting daily cleaning and maintenance of day use facilities including bathrooms, parking areas and picnic pavilions
- Responding to maintenance issues such as minor repairs to buildings or other infrastructure
- Working outside and in all weather conditions
- Lifting up to 50lbs
- Operating work trucks & trailers on public roads
- As part of the Hamilton Conservation Authority team you may be scheduled and asked to report to a different conservation area to assist with special events, staffing shortages, etc. throughout the length of your employment period
